Our Guest Preacher

The Rev. Craig Marshall is pastor of Bullock Creek Presbyterian Church in Bullock Creek, SC where he has served since 2011. A native of Wilmington, DE, he is a graduate of the University of Delaware and Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte. He and his wife Kim have three grown children, Nathan, Abbey and Sam. The Marshalls served with *Mission to the World* in Belize from 2004-2008.

Our Guest Missionaries

Veteran missionaries **Garry and Anita Chambers** have served with Mission to the World in various capacities in the Caribbean region since 1982, including 15 years at the Hospital of Light in southern Haiti, and over 13 years at the Presbyterian Medical Clinic in Patchakan, Belize. In 2015, Garry took the role of MTW leadership as the Regional Director and Council Coordinator for the Caribbean region. In 2018, he took on the additional role of Regional Director for MTW's Indigenous Ministries to North America.

Marty and Sara Driggers have been with *Wycliffe Bible Translators* since 2010. From 2012 to 2019 they served in Papua New Guinea, and now find themselves transitioning to a new U.S.-based assignment as partnership coaches for Wycliffe. Sara is currently training for that role while Marty is currently working for a private

business as they continue to seek support for their ministry with Wycliffe. The Driggers have four daughters, Taylor, Tia, Miriam, and Jade.

Brian Howard is the new campus minister for *Reformed University Fellowship-International* at *Clemson University*. A veteran pastor and church planter in the PCA, he replaced our old friend Rick Brawner who retired from that role last summer. He and his wife Missy have four children, Caleb, Connor, Joe, and Jadyn.

Debbie Richards has served the Lord with *Mission to the World* as a in Chiba, Japan now for over 25 years. From Greenwood, SC, she went to Japan first as a short-term missionary with the MTW-IMPACT program and ministered for three years through its church planting team in Chiba. Debbie returned to Chiba in 2001 as a long-term missionary with MTW team where her continuing ministry includes teaching English classes and serving as pianist for two of the church plants.
