Our Guest Preacher

We welcome back to the Olivet pulpit our friend the **Rev. Archie Moore**. Having served for Pastor of Greenwood Presbyterian Church (PCA) for more than two decades, Archie now serves as Chaplain at Ridgehaven Camp and Conference Center in Brevard, NC, while continuing in a part-time capacity on the pastoral staff of Greenwood Presbyterian. Archie and his wife, Glenda, have five adult children and nine grandchildren.

Our Missionaries

Roger and Laura Dye served for sixteen years as missionaries in Chile with Mission to the World, and since 2013, with FamilyLife Global where Roger serves as the Assistant to the Director for Latin America, working to equip pastors and leaders to strengthen marriages and families throughout the continent. FamilyLife is a ministry of Cru (formerly known as Campus Crusade for Christ). The Dyes have four young adult-aged children: Deanna, Isaac, Hudson, and Suzy. They currently

reside in Winnsboro, SC, ministering throughout Latin America as well as the Hispanic communities of NC, SC, GA, and TN.

Marty and Sara Driggers joined *Wycliffe Bible Translators* in 2010 and served in Papua New Guinea from 2012 to 2019. They currently reside in Lynchburg, VA where Sara serves as a partnership development coach, advising and encouraging new and established Wycliffe missionaries as they seek prayer and financial partners. *Wycliffe Bible Translators*, which was founded in 1942, continues to strive to the goal of making the Bible available to all people in a language and form they clearly understand. The Driggers have four daughters, Taylor, Tia, Miriam, and Jade, and, as of last month, a new son-in-law, Andrew (married to Miriam).

In response to God’s leading, the **Michael and Tricia Lee** accepted a call in 2007 from *Mission to the World* to do theological training and coaching of church planters, and mercy ministry in Monterrey, Mexico. After completing nearly four years of preparation and work on the field, in 2014 the Lees sensed and accepted a more challenging call: to assist in establishing a new work where none had previously existed in Panama City, Panamá. In addition to church planting in Panamá, the Lees coordinate member care for MTW Latin America. The purpose of member care is to ensure that MTW’s missionaries are receiving the spiritual care they need to grow and thrive as God’s people on the field.

Debbie Richards has served the Lord with Mission to the World as a in Chiba, Japan now for over 25 years. From Greenwood, SC, she went to Japan first as a short-term missionary with the MTW-IMPACT program and ministered for three years through its church planting team in Chiba. Debbie returned to Chiba in 2001 as a long-term missionary with MTW team where her continuing ministry includes teaching English classes and serving as pianist for two of the church plants.

Peter and Diane Bakelaar have served in Japan since 1990. Peter’s responsibilities include evangelistic Bible studies, discipleship, and communication of the gospel in Japanese through special events and messages. Diane serves in many aspects of the team’s ministry including hospitality in the home. The Bakelaars are committed to knowing Christ and making Him known among the Japanese. Thank you for praying that they will faithfully fulfill the vision of the Nagoya Church Planting Team, which is training Japanese to reach Japan and the world for Christ.

Brian Howard is the campus minister for Reformed University Fellowship-International at Clemson University. A veteran pastor and church planter in the PCA, he replaced our old friend Rick Brawner who retired from that in 2019. He and his wife Missy have four children, Caleb, Connor, Joe, and Jodyn.
