Our Guest Preacher

Our special guest preacher this year is **the Rev. Chuck McArthur**. Chuck is a veteran PCA church planter and pastor who now serves as Executive Director of Equipping Leaders International (ELI). And yes, he's also Pastor Chip's younger brother. A graduate of Belhaven College and Reformed Theological Seminary in Jackson, Mississippi, Chuck met his wife Sheree in 1980 while at Belhaven, and they were married the following year. They currently reside in St. Augustine, Florida. They have three grown sons, two wonderful daughter-in-laws, three handsome funloving grandsons, and a beautiful Costa Rican granddaughter.

Our Missionaries

We are delighted to have back and joining us this weekend two of Olivet's supported missionary couples. **Roger and Laura Dye** served for sixteen years as missionaries in Chile with Mission to the World, and since 2013, with FamilyLife Global where Roger serves as the Assistant to the Director of Hispanic Ministries, working to equip pastors and leaders to strengthen marriages and families. FamilyLife is a ministry of Cru (formerly known as Campus Crusade for Christ). The Dyes have four grown children: Deanna, Isaac, Hudson, and Suzy Grace, one granddaughter and three grandsons. They currently reside in Winnsboro, SC, ministering throughout Latin America as well as the Hispanic communities of NC, SC, GA, and TN.

Garry and Anita Chambers have served in the Caribbean area since 1982 and have witnessed God working in amazing ways throughout the country of Haiti and surrounding areas. After meeting at LeTourneau University, God called them together to serve at Hospital of Light in southern Haiti for 15 years, where they ministered, raised their family, and saw many people come to know Christ.

In 2002 the Lord led them to northern Belize to assist at the Presbyterian Medical Clinic in the village of Patchakan. Garry initially worked as the clinic

administrator, then trained a Belizean to take his place and worked among the Presbyterian churches in discipleship, evangelism, preaching, and teaching. (OVER) He currently serves on the boards of the seminary and clinic. Anita, an R.N., ministered as nursing manager, promoting spiritual and community health and supported the local church leadership. The clinic is now staffed completely by Belizean nationals and the churches have a vision for discipleship and growth.

In January 2015, Garry took the role of MTW leadership as the regional director and council coordinator for the Caribbean region, giving oversight and developing MTW ministries throughout the Caribbean. Garry and Anita enjoy teaching, leading marriage seminars, and ministering to MTW missionaries and national partners. Garry was also asked to serve as the regional director for Indigenous Ministries to North America-MTW in August 2018.
